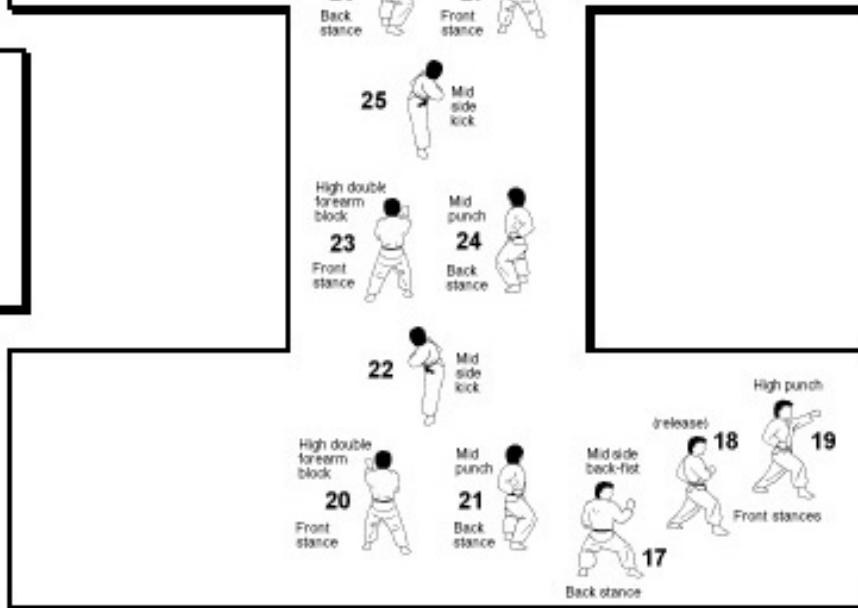
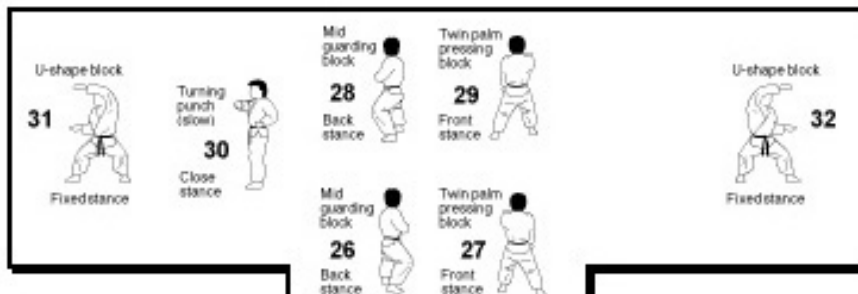

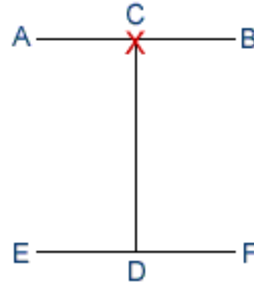


CHOONG-GUN

A Korean patriot who assassinated the first Japanese Governor-General of Korea.
(32 movements)

JOONGGUNGNUN

32 Moves



JOONG-GUN is named after the patriot Ahn Joong-Gun who assassinated Hiro-Bumi Ito, the first Japanese governor-general of Korea, known as the man who played the leading part in the Korea-Japan merger. There are 32 movements in this pattern to represent Mr. Ahn's age when he was executed in a Lui-Shung prison (1910).

L-stance middle reverse knifehand block.

Low side front snap kick.

Rear foot stance middle upwards palm block.

Walking stance upper elbow strike.

Walking stance twin vertical punch.

Walking stance twin upset punch.

Walking stance X-fist rising block.

L-stance middle reverse forefist punch.

Low stance palm pressing block.

Closed stance middle forefist angular punch.

Fixed stance U-shape *archand* block.
