


inventor of the first armored battleship in the year 1592 A.D.

## 30 Moves



CHOONG-MOO was the name given to the great Admiral Yi Soon-Sin of the Lee Dynasty. He was reputed to have invented the first armoured battleship (Kobukson) in 1592, which is said to be the precursor of the present day submarine. The reason why this pattern ends with a left hand attack is to symbolize his regrettable death, having no chance to show his unrestrained potentiality checked by the forced reservation of his loyalty to the king.

Walking stance high Gunnan so nopunde anuro inwards knifehand strike. sonkal taerigi. Flying side piercing kick. Twimyo yop cha jirugi. L-stance low outer forearm Niunja so najunde bakat palmok block. makgi. Middle back piercing kick. Kaunde dwit cha jirugi. Fixed stance U-shape block. Gojung so digutja makgi. Gunnan so dwijibun sonkut Walking stance **upset** fingertip thrust. tulgi. L-stance middle X-Niun ja so kaunde kyocha knifehand **checking** block. sonkal **momchau** makgi.
